Kawasaki City celebrates its 100th anniversary in 2024. During Edo Era (1603-1868), the city prospered as a post town on the Tokaido, and it has developed as an industrial city for technology and manufacturing. Today it has many facilities for cuisine and shopping. Walk around the city as you please and discover your favorite spots.

TOPIC / Newly Reborn Kawasaki City Hall Main Building

The main building was rebuilt in 2023. It has a restored building, partially restored from the old main building, and an atrium, making this a place that people are fond of. This building is also a new landmark in Kawasaki City where you can enjoy the superb view from the sky deck on the 25F observation floor.

1 KAWASUI Kawasaki Aquarium *Tourist Spots*

Located on the 9th and 10th floors of Kawasaki LeFRONT, this is a new sensation of urban-style aquarium where you can experience beautiful waterfront with all 5 senses, from the local Tama River to world waterfronts.

2 KAWASAKI UKIYO-E GALLERY SAITO FUMIO COLLECTION *Tourist Spots*

From their collection of over 5,000 Ukiyo-e works, they completely change the displayed works almost every month. You can feel free to enjoy the exhibition with a very low fee.

3 Ganso New Tantan Sakaba *Chinese Food / Ramen*

A new kind of business format has been added to the popular Ganso New Tantanmen Hoppo. Fluffy beaten eggs are entwined with the soft and sticky homemade noodles.

4 Tenryu Ginzagaiten *Chinese Food / Ramen*

TENRYU is a Chinese restaurant located 5 minutes from Kawasaki Station. They have 4 restaurants located around Kawasaki Station. Inside the restaurant surrounded by a counter, They have a wide selection of ramen, alcohol snacks.

5 Italian Restaurant Monarizan *Western Food*

Founded in 1964. Authentic Italian that goes beyond the times and is beloved by local people. For lunch you can enjoy their popular specialty casserole, and for dinner you can enjoy courses and original cuisine.

6 MINOTO *Udon / Soba*

A long-standing soba restaurant founded in 1914. They offer standard soba menu options, as well as set meals with half a serving of soba at lunch, and hotpot courses and individual foods that go well with sake for dinner.

7 TOKAIDO BEER *Izakaya / Bar*

Wheat fields once spread out in Kawasaki-shuku, a post town on the old Tokaido. At this beer pub that also serves as a brewery, you can enjoy original craft beer.

8 MIYADAI CLUB *Japanese Food*

A restaurant directly managed by a long-standing meat wholesaler founded in 1932. Here, you can enjoy meat cuisine such as high-quality Wagyu beef sukiyaki, shabu shabu, and ceramic-griddled food, in a relaxing atmosphere at reasonable prices.

9 CAFE IBIS *Cafe / Bakery*

At this stylish space made from a renovated old building, you can enjoy high quality roasted coffee. The hamburgers and spicy curry are also recommended.

10 TONKATSU WAKO *Japanese Food*
KAWASAKI AZALEA HONTEN

The main branch of WAKO, a tonkatsu (pork cutlet) restaurant that has expanded to over 250 branches across Japan. This tonkatsu restaurant was founded over half a century ago, and features food with crispy batter textures and delicious flavors of juicy meat.

11 Eel/Kappo MARUDAI *Japanese Food*

This long-standing Japanese restaurant was founded in 1921. Its building has an extremely romantic feel. Their eel, which is carefully cooked, fragrant and packed with delicious flavors, is a masterpiece.

12 Izakaya Marudai Hall *Izakaya / Bar*

Cheap, fast, and delicious! A popular izakaya bar that opens from the morning. They have a restaurant menu such as Japanese and Chinese food, so guests can freely use it.
